**3 July 2024**

### **LAKE LESCHENAULTIA**

#### **10km walk**

Enjoy the serenity and beauty of the Lake Leschenaultia Camp Site and Nature Reserve. This is an easily navigable, undulating walk, mainly along shaded paths. One morning tea stop has been planned at approximately the halfway point, with a lunch stop back at the camp picnic tables.

**7 August 2024**

### **BIBBULMUN TRACK: BROOKTON HIGHWAY TO ABYSSINIA ROCK RETURN**

#### **10km walk**

This section of the Bibbulmun Track climbs gently through attractive forest before descending to Abyssinia Rock, a spectacular sight. The rock can also be climbed and makes a good place for morning tea.

**4 September 2024**

### **MUNDAY BROOK**

#### **10km walk**

This circuit walk in the Korung National Park is in an attractive area of bushland near Karragullen. Tracks are gravel and mostly level with a few gentle rises. The mixed regrowth forest was extensively logged in the 19<sup>th</sup> century.

**2 October 2024**

### **GLEN FORREST SUPER BLOCK + RAILWAY HERITAGE TRAIL**

#### **~10km walk**

The Super Block is an area of connected pockets of remnant forest near Darlington. In spring there should be many wildflowers. Tracks are gravel with a steeper descent to Nyaania Creek (Poles recommended). The walk also follows part of the Railway heritage trail to Glen Forrest for morning tea and then returning to the super block for a series of gentle climbs back to the start.

**6 November 2024**

### **CANNING CIRCUIT UPSTREAM**

#### **~10km walk**

An interesting walk beside the Canning River passing the Casteldare railway, the old Sikh cremation grounds and shady riverside walking tracks. Tracks are all level and well-formed.
